**NEW PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:**

DAW Tactical Division has done it again by producing another outstanding product. The collapsible version of the Little Special Operations Bunker (S.O.B.) is by far one of the most revolutionary products on the market. It gives the same great ballistic protection and coverage as the standard S.O.B with increased portability. The collapsible Little S.O.B is described as a portable rifle grade rolling ballistic shield/bunker which can be easily transported in any standard patrol vehicle. It rapidly deploys creating rifle grade cover for any armed confrontation. It furthermore provides maximum coverage for its size however rolls extremely easily (one operator). Never before could this level of protection and coverage be collapsed, transported, assembled and then effectively maneuvered by one operator. I found that I could easily maneuver this product while still effectively handling my rifle or sub gun.

**REASONABLY PRICED:**

I believe that all of the DAW Tactical Division products are priced very reasonable for the protection they provide. The affordable price allows for smaller agency's to acquire rifle grade protection for their Officers without spending the large sum of money to purchase an Armored Personnel Carrier (A.P.C.) The DAW Tactical products are a fraction of the cost of an A.P.C without the constant maintenance issues associated with vehicles.

**OPERATOR FIELD ISSUES/CURRENT GAPS FILED:**

The S.O.B line of products helps bridge the gap between current shields and A.P.C's. This specific problem exists in the SWAT community when SWAT teams are faced with armed barricade and hostage type scenarios or rapid response in multi level or large indoor structures. A.P.C's are a great asset but are basically limited to ground levels or vehicle accessible entrances (where they can be driven). Shields for years have also been mainstay tool; however the majority of manageable shields carried by SWAT operators are limited to handgun protection. The new homeland security threats emerging require for rifle grade protection as well as protection from Improvised Explosive Devices I.E.D's. The products manufactured and designed by DAW allow for the units to be disassembled and carried by operators. This basic concept allows for rifle grade protection and mobile protection for I.E.D's basically anywhere operators can go. I have utilized all of the DAW products and have found them to be extremely effective tool. Even the largest of the DAW products can easily and quickly be disassembled and put on an elevator or carried by operators up stairs.
